



Benefit from the 2011 PayWell and HR Benchmarking studies

PwC Human Resources Services team is opening another year of PayWell and HR Benchmarking studies. *PayWell* is the largest sector-oriented **study of remuneration**, which offers customers an overview of the current situation in salaries and employee benefits on the Slovak market. The package includes complete analyses of salaries and benefits within the company by sector and regions, and as well tax and legal information focused on the area of remuneration and benefits. It maps trends in the development of basic and total salaries and employee benefits provided in almost 500 job positions. The survey outputs are an important tool for effective remuneration planning in companies striving to succeed in the competition for recruiting, retaining, and motivating high-quality staff.

HR Benchmarking is a study which examines **key indicators of the human resource management**. It allows monitoring the linkage between efficiency of the human resource management system, company's financial results and its overall productivity.

The study is based on the international methodology of the PwC Saratoga Institute. In the survey, we measure almost 100 indicators related to HR management, divided into several groups: organisation results, remuneration and employee benefits, behaviour in the organization, recruitment and selection, education and development, and organizational structure.
